ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Any graduating high school senior is eligible to receive the scholarship providing the student meets requirements—

1. Must be a bowler and a member of the Indiana State USBC
2. Must be a high school senior
3. Must meet one (1) of the following:
 - a. Enrollment as a full-time student with a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester at an Indiana College, university or institution offering a Bachelor degree programs
 - b. Enrollment at an Indiana institution offering an Associate degree in Bowling Center Management or Lane Maintenance
4. Enrollment must be for the fall semester or quarter immediately following high school graduation
5. Continued eligibility is dependent upon maintenance of consecutive collegiate semesters.
6. Must file an application furnished by the IS USBC Scholarship Committee, giving complete information as required thereon, postmarked by MAY 1
7. Must have Amateur status in all Athletics

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- **Step 1**—Complete appropriately the Indiana State USBC Scholarships Application
- **Step 2**—Submit in your own handwriting an essay of not less than 150 words and not more than 200 words, telling what your specific college plans are. Judging will be based on plans, clarity, organization, logic and neatness.
- **Step 3**—Give your IS USBC youth coach your essay and Application Page 3 of the application form and a stamped envelope addressed to the Association Manager of the ISUSBC. Ask your ISUSBC youth coach to complete page 3 entirely. The coach should then mail the essay and page 3 to the Association Manager of the ISUSBC prior to MAY 1.
- **Step 4**—Give Application Page 4 to your high school counselor along with a stamped envelope addressed to the Association Manager of the ISUSBC. Ask the counselor to complete page 4 entirely and mail it to the Association Manager of the ISUSBC prior to MAY 1.
- **Step 5**—Check with your ISUSBC youth coach and counselor by February 20 to assure that all application forms are being completed or have been sent to the ISUSBC Association Manager.
- **Step 6**—Send a letter of thank you to your IS USBC youth coach and counselor for their cooperation and assistance.
