## TOURNAMENT RULES 2019 INDIANA STATE JAMBOREE BLIND DRAW DOUBLES TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1.) This tournament is open to Indiana State and Local Association Officers, Directors and Board members including IBA and WISBA past officers and the tournament will be USBC Certified. Upon request, bowlers must display a current valid USBC sanction card or a league receipt for the current year signed by the League Secretary.
- 2.) This is a "Blind Draw Doubles Tournament" that is being run as part of the activities for the 2019 Indiana State Jamboree. All bowlers will submit individual entries for the tournament and the tournament officials will randomly make up the doubles teams that will compete in the tournament. Bowlers may compete only once and will bowl a three (3) game block on the same pair of lanes during the tournament. Standings and prizes will be based on the total of actual pinfall plus handicap for the two bowlers on each team.
- 3.) The Tournament will be conducted on a handicap basis as follows: To the actual scores shall be added a handicap of **90%** of the difference between the team's average and 44**0**. Any team having an average of 440 or greater shall bowl scratch.
- 4.) AVERAGES: Averages for determining handicaps shall be: Use highest USBC sanctioned league average based on a minimum of 21 games for the 2018-2019 season. All other bowlers will bowl scratch. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average, and if the reported average is less than their actual average, the bowler will be disqualified and all prizes won as a result of the incorrect average will be forfeited. If the reported average is higher, prizes will be based on reported average. The bowler is responsible for providing verification of the average to be used to the tournament manager.
- 5.) The cost of participation for this tournament is \$20.00. This fee is comprised of \$11.75 prize fund & \$8.25 lineage/expenses. The prize fees will be returned 100 % in cash prizes to the bowlers. The prize ratio will be one paid position for every six paid entries. Entries postmarked after August 3rd or walkins the day of the tournament will have an additional late fee of \$25.
- 6.) All bowlers must check in at the tournament desk. The tournament officials on a random basis will have assigned team members and lanes previously; no switching of partners will be permitted.
- 7.) Bowling shall begin in accordance with a previously arranged schedule. (Any player or team arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled and receive a zero score for all previous frames.)
- 8.) Ten minutes of practice will be provided before the start of the Tournament Squad.
- 9.) The provisions of Rule 319, sections C, D & E are not in effect for this Tournament.
- 10.) Rule 400 does apply to this tournament.
- 11.) Tournament entries will close August 3, 2019.

#### LUISE LESSER TOURNAMENT RULES AND FORMAT

- 1. **This tournament is certified** by the USBC and shall be governed by the rules of the USBC. Rule 400 will apply. This tournament is open to all 2018/19 certified youth and adult bowlers. If the tournament is delayed due to power outages/breakdowns, USBC rule #321 will apply.
- 2. This tournament will use the bowlers highest 2018/19 certified season ending average for 15 games or more; summer averages WILL NOT apply UNLESS it is the only certifiable average the bowler has for the 2018-19 season. AVERAGE VERFICATION MUST BE PROVIDED AT CHECK-IN via final league standing sheet or print out from Bowl.com. Failure to provide average verification will result in the bowler using a 200 average. Bowlers using an incorrect average will result in their score being disqualified and any winnings being forfeited. Certified sport league averages will be rerated per USBC guidelines. Rule 319d and 319e will be waived.
- 3. Entry fees are broken down as follows: Prize Fund \$35.00, Bowling Fee \$11.00, Breast Cancer Donation & Expense Fee \$4.00. Awards returned 100%.
- 4. <u>Entry Fees</u>: No entry accepted without payment. <u>Payments may be made in cash or check/money order made payable to "ISUSBC"</u>. Walk-in entries are <u>CASH ONLY</u> on the day of qualifying competition and welcomed, space providing.
- 5. <u>Divisions/Handicap</u>: Youth divisions will consist of Scratch Boys, Scratch Girls, 161 and Over Handicap (Combined), 121-160 Handicap (Combined), and 120 and Under Handicap (Combined). Adult divisions will be Scratch and Handicap. All Handicap divisions will be 90% of 200.
- 6. Format/Scoring: Bowlers will receive ten (10) minutes of practice and bowl four (4) games on the same pair of lanes. The total pin series for the three highest games will determine the winner. Ties will be broken by the total four (4) game series. If still tied, the bowler with the highest last game of the series will determine the winner. The tournament follows a one (1) lane courtesy rule (no more, no less). Please be ready to bowl when it is your turn. A bowler arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled; frames missed shall be credited with a zero. Scoring for the JG qualifier will be the actual total of all four (4) games; no handicap will be included.
- 7. <u>Jr Gold Optional Event</u>: An optional Jr Gold (JG) qualifier is offered with this tournament provided there are enough bowlers to fill a division. Boys and girls may be combined to fill divisions if necessary; notification will be given. Bowlers must bowl the regular tournament in order to participate in the JG qualifier. Entry fee for the JG qualifier is \$25.00. All bowlers in the qualifier must be a JG member; memberships may be purchased on site for an additional fee. <a href="The last 4">The last 4</a> digits of the bowlers social security number is required to process all JG memberships, winners, and alternates.
- 8. <u>Dress Code</u>: All bowlers must wear suitable attire. No short shorts, bare mid-drifts, or cut-offs permitted or clothing with offensive writing, alcohol or tobacco products. <u>Breast cancer awareness and pink attire is highly encouraged!!</u>
- 9. Only bowlers and Tournament Officials shall be permitted in the settee area during competition.
- 10. After a score has been recorded, it cannot be changed unless there is an obvious error in scoring or calculation. Questionable errors shall be decided on by the Tournament Directors. Claims for errors must be made to Tournament Directors no later than 24 hours after the completion of the tournament and UNOFFICIAL scores are posted.
- 11. No alcoholic beverages will be served during this tournament.
- 12. Protests and appeals must be in writing stating the grounds for the protest or appeal. A protest involving eligibility or playing rules must be filed with the Tournament Directors within 36 hours of the completion of the tournament. The decision of the Tournament Directors shall be final, unless a written appeal is filed with the local association or USBC Headquarters and within 24 hours of notice of the decision. Upon notification of a protest or appeal, the Tournament Directors must withhold all affected prizes until the protest or appeal is resolved. The decision of the local association may also be appealed to USBC Headquarters. The decision of USBC Headquarters is final and binding on all involved parties.
- 13. <u>Awards</u>: Scholarships will be awarded in all youth divisions and shall be returned 100% to bowlers based on at least a one (1) and six (6) ratio. Scholarships will be administered by the ISUSBC with funds being sent to the Smart Program at the USBC National Office. Adults will receive \$100 for first place based on 25 entries per division. Any extra prize fund money will be put towards youth scholarships.
- 14. In consideration of ISUSBC, conducting the Tournament releases ISUSBC and USBC from any and all liability for any injury or accident involving entrant as a result of entrant participating therein.
- 15. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations shall be determined by the USBC Rule Book and the Tournament Director(s). Any further protest will be determined by the USBC Rules Department.
