The Hall of Fame ballots will be in the mail just after the holidays with one (1) each going to each Indiana State local association, the Hall of Fame Members, and the Indiana State USBC Board of Directors. Each ballot will be allowed to vote for up to six (6) candidates. The local association ballot will be sent to the association manager. We highly encourage you to discuss with your local board of directors for a vote/consensus on who your association feels are the best nominees. It shouldn't be just the association manager's decision.

As per direction of the state HOF guidelines and procedure, which is published on the website, all nominees who meet the criteria have been be placed on the Hall of Fame ballot for consideration. This year there were 16 qualified nominees. The top two receiving the most votes will be automatically inducted; any other nominee who receives over 50% of those ballots/votes returned will also be inducted. Potentially, there could be the top two with the most votes returned plus four others that could receive enough votes. We highly recommend you vote for six candidates who you feel have the best qualifications and return your ballot as soon as possible. Additional instructions will be mailed with the ballots.
