# CONGRATUALATIONS! 2022 Hall of Fame Inductees



Hall of Fame 2022 Inductee Eugene McCune is from Gr Calumet Area USBC, and he is the son of 1998 Hall of Fame Member Don McCune.

Eugene is an accomplished bowler as a PBA bowler, Indiana State bowler, and at

the Local Association level. Eugene was inducted into the Gr Calumet USBC Hall of Fame in 2014.

- He still holds the 9-game record with a total pinfall of 2468 (274.22 average)
- The 14-game record with 3647 (260.5 average)
- He has 3 PBA National Titles and 3 PBA 50 National Titles
- 24 PBA Regional Titles and 3 PBA 50 Regional Titles
- In 2019, Eugene was the PBA Senior Rookie of the Year

# 2022 Hall of Fame Inductee George Webb (Posthumously) Indy USBC 1/14/1928-10/8/2019



Since 1990, George had done so much for the youth bowling in the State of Indiana, and among his services, he was the President of the Youth Organization from 2000-2008.

He began in 1990 overseeing the Youth State Tournament with his wife, Vera, until 2014. During that time, entries rose to over 1100 teams. In 1994, George had a great idea that he discussed with his counterpart in the State of Kentucky, Bob Vogt. Their insight, along with Royal Pin's Don Mitchell, became the summer series "Indiana/Kentucky All Stars," and by 1997, the first series was held at Expo Bowl in Indianapolis with each odd year being hosted in Indianapolis and each even year hosted by Lexington and Louisville, Kentucky. George continued to oversee the Indiana program until 2018.

He began working at Woodland Bowl in 1976 and became involved with youth bowling.

Following are some of George Webb's services and accomplishments:

- Past President and member of Bowl Indiana Council
- With assistance of Don Mitchell and Jim Doty, began the first In-School bowling programs in Indiana
- With assistance of Cathy Cooper, he worked for the State of Indiana to be the first state in the country to have bowling in a Children's Museum
- In the early 1980's, helped with the transition of youth bowling from AJBC to YABA
- Was appointed State Representative for YABA for the State of Indiana and served until the organization was reorganized
- In 1990, George became the tournament manager for the Indiana State Youth Tournament; he helped to grow the State Youth tournament from 700 teams to over 1000 teams and the Master and Queens Tournament from 70 teams to over 250 teams
- He was elected President of the State YABA/ISUSBCYA in 2000 and served until his retirement in 2008

- In 1994, George was offered a position with Young America Bowling Association (YABA) in which he was a state manager for youth activities helping to develop programs that included "in school bowling program."
- In 1998, founded the Indiana Kentucky All Star Tournament with every participant receiving scholarship monies
- In 2004, helped to found the Midwest All Star Tournament; in 2008, assisted in forming a new State Tournament for younger bowlers, known as the Prince and Princess Tournament; he helped to develop and start the State Adult/Youth Scholarship Tournament
- Served as Tournament Manager for International Family Tournament for eight years
- Co-Chaired the National Junior Gold Tournament held in Indianapolis in 2005 with Deloris Webb in 2009 and 2010
- Assisted by Corky Koch, founded the Dick Lyke Memorial Scholarship Tournament
- Had served on the Board of Directors for High School Bowling since its beginning
