## **Challenge Tournament Rules**

- 1. This tournament is open to all associations within the Indiana State USBC.
- 2. Teams consist of 5 people. All team members must be a current board member of a State or Local Association, a life member, a local or state Hall of Fame member, or staff members/employees of a state or local association. Teams may be all male, female or mixed. Members must be in good standing with a current USBC membership.
- 3. In the Qualifying round, all teams will bowl two (2) standard team games and 3 Baker-System games for seeding purposes into the elimination round brackets. The top 16 teams will advance to the double elimination bracket round.
- 4. The Double Elimination Round will then be bowled using the Baker-System format scoring. The top 16 Teams after qualifying will be seeded into the Winners' Bracket based on their qualifying totals. Any tie for seeding position will be determined by the highest Regular team game from the qualifying round, if still tied, the highest Qualifying Baker Game will determine the winner. If there is a tie for the last spot in the playoff round it will be determined by a 1 Game Baker-System format rolloff. If still tied, a 9th and 10th frame roll off using 2 players of the captain's choice from each team will determine the advancing team.
- 5. Each match in the Double Elimination Round will be 1 Baker-System format game. All teams start in the WINNERS bracket, if you win your match you stay in the WINNERS bracket. If you lose a match you move to the ELIMINATION bracket. If you win your match in the ELIMINATION bracket you advance to the next round. When you lose a match for the second time you are eliminated from the tournament and receive the prize payout for that round and place. Ties are broken by a 9th and 10th frame roll off 2 players of the captain's choice, until a winner is determined.
- 6. Scratch scoring only, NO HANDICAP.
- 7. The winning District will host the next year's event at a bowling center of their choice.
- 8. Luncheon will follow immediately after qualification rounds.
- 9. Individual Brackets, Individual High Game Pots, 50/50 drawings and a Ball Raffle may be available to help offset expenses and prizes.
- 10. All entries must be received by September 30, 2022 in order to provide a meal and lane count for the event.
