Brackets & Mystery Game

- Pay \$5 or \$2 before Squad begins...
- Paying \$5 per bracket; payout without a bye is 1st place—\$25 and 2nd place—\$10
- Paying \$2 per bracket; payout without a bye is 1st place—\$10 and 2nd place—\$4
- Pay \$5 before Squad begins for High Game Handicap; \$5 for High Game Scratch; series included with both; payout based on number of entries
- Pay \$5 before Squad begins for Mystery Game—pays 1st, 2nd, and 3rd games only; payout based on entries; if you bowled the Mystery number drawn, you win the pot; ties split the pot between winners

2023 USBC Senior Championship Qualifier

Roll-off qualifier (Rule #15): A 3-game qualifier will be held on June 10 (tentatively) at the tournament site, in order to determine the State representatives to the 2024 USBC National Senior Championships. The top 3 Open and Women's division handicap scores in each class will be eligible to return. The representative will be the bowler with the highest 6-game score. In case of a tie at the end of the roll-off competition, there will be an additional 9th and 10th frames bowled to determine the representative.

Tournament Awards/Recognitions

- Bowling Ball for any tournament participant who bowls a 300 game (one ball only per tournament per individual) bowled in the current State Seniors Tournament
- Bowling Ball for any tournament participant who bowls an 800 series (one ball only per tournament per individual) bowled in the current State Seniors Tournament
- Award (Jackets) for First Place Champions
- Classic Bowler Pin (75+ Pin)

2023 Indiana State USBC Senior Championship Rules

Prize fee returned 100% Prize ratio: at least 1 in 6

- This is a singles handicap tournament; it is open to bowlers in a USBC certified Indiana league, 50 years of age and over, as of April 1. Singles Handicap Event is mandatory; all other events are optional.
- The Tournament will have an Open division and a Women's division. Bowlers must present a current year USBC membership card to bowl.
- Age for tournament classifications will be as of April 1, 2023. Entries without a birthdate may be rejected.
- 4. Handicap shall be 100% of the difference between bowler's average and 230. Handicap base for doubles will be 460, handicap base for team event will be 920. There will be a scratch prize list for bowlers who pay the optional scratch prize fee.
- 5. The tournament will be singles of four (4) games with the three highest games counted for score.
- 6. There will be an Optional Doubles event. Any combination of a men's, women's, or mixed doubles team is permitted. Scores for the singles event (best 3 of 4) will be combined to create the doubles prize list. Bowlers may bowl on up to five (5) doubles teams, with different partners. Doubles team members bowling on different squads may participate, but entries must be received before either member bowls in the tournament.
- 7. There will be an Optional 4-person Team event. Any combination of four bowlers may make up a team. Teams will bowl three (3) games. Multiple participation in team event will be allowed with two bowlers changed per team.
- 8. Scratch event: In 2023, we will continue with a scratch prize list. Entry fee is \$5.00 per event per bowler. 100% of entry fee will be paid out in prize funds. For team, all four (4) members must pay the optional scratch prize fee. For doubles, both partners must pay the fee. All entrants must be entered into the handicap event(s).
- Entering Average: Bowlers will use their highest 2021-2022 average, based on a minimum of 21 games. Summer averages may also be used, based on 21 games. If no 2021-22 average, current

- average of 21 games will be used. All others will bowl scratch.
- 10. Ten-pin rule: If current season average for at least 21 games at the time of bowling exceeds last season's average by 10 or more pins, the current season average must be used (Rule 319a-3).
- Reporting of previous tournament prize winnings will NOT apply.
- 12. It is each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their own average in handicap tournaments, whether submitted by the bowler, team captain, or others. Failure to use the correct average may disqualify the score if the submitted average is lower than the correct average. If the submitted average is higher than the correct average, prize winnings will be based on the submitted average.
- 13. Average corrections may be made up until the end of the first game of competition (Rule 319a-4)
- 14. Prizes: Cash prizes will be awarded for each event, based on the number of entries received. There will be a scratch prize list for bowlers who pay the optional scratch prize fee. Prize ratio will be at least 1 for every 6 entries.
- 15. Roll-off qualifier: A 3-game qualifier will be held on May 14 (tentatively) at the tournament site, in order to determine the State representatives to the 2024 USBC National Senior Championships. The top 3 Open and Women's division handicap scores in each class will be eligible to return. The representative will be the bowler with the highest 6-game score. In case of a tie at the end of the roll-off competition, there will be an additional 9th and 10th frames bowled to determine the representative.
- 16. Late entries will be accepted 7 days before bowling date, based on lane availability. A late fee of \$5.00 per singles entry, \$10.00 per doubles entry, and \$20.00 per team entry will be assessed.
- 17. Any rules not covered herein are governed by USBC rules.




