INSTRUCTIONS AND APPLICATION

- \$1000 Indiana State USBC Star of Tomorrow Scholarship (Male or Female)
- \$1000 Indiana State USBC Male or Female Performance Scholarship
- \$1000 Indiana State USBC Male or Female Scholarship (based on meritorious service)

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Any high school junior or senior is eligible to receive the scholarship providing the student meets requirements. ***Application will not be considered without ALL REQUIRED INFORMATION.***

Scholarships will be distributed through the SMART program.

1. Must be a bowler and a member of the Indiana State USBC for at least 3 years
2. Must be a high school senior or high school junior. (A Junior winner is not able to apply again their Senior year.)
3. Must meet the following:
 - a. Enrollment as a full-time student, and
 - b. Have a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester at any College, university or institution offering an Associate/Bachelor degree programs
4. Enrollment must be for the fall semester or quarter immediately following high school graduation
5. Must file an application furnished by the IS USBC Scholarship Committee, giving complete information as required thereon, postmarked by **MARCH 31**
6. Must have Amateur status in all Athletics

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- **Step 1**—Completely submit the current Indiana State USBC Scholarship Application
- **Step 2**—Submit an essay of not less than 100 words and not more than 150 words, telling what your specific college plans are. Judging will be based on plans, clarity, organization, and logic.
 - Complete the second section with your bowling accomplishments, recognitions, awards, earned bowling scholarships, etc.
- **Step 3**—Give your IS USBC youth coach the link to Page 5 of the Application Form. Deadline is midnight, March 31.
 - If you request them to submit by postal mail, provide them Page 5, with an addressed, stamped envelope **to the IS USBC Association Manager.**
- **Step 4**—Give your high school counselor the link to Page 6 of the Application Form. Deadline is midnight, March 31.
 - If you request them to submit by postal mail, provide them Page 6, with an addressed, stamped envelope **to the IS USBC Association Manager.**
- **Step 5**—Check with your IS USBC youth coach and counselor by February 14 to assure that all application forms, transcript, and supporting documentation are being completed or have been sent to the IS USBC Association Manager.
- **Step 6**—Send a letter of thank you to your IS USBC youth coach and counselor for their cooperation and assistance.
