Lynda Isaacs has been involved in bowling since the age of four, and she has had many experiences in the world of bowling coming through a variety of avenues in both the competition and the business sectors.

After being elected to the Wayne County WBA as Director in 1992, she served for 13 years until the merger in 2006; Lynda was then elected to the newly merged Wayne County USBC Board of Directors as she continued servicing the bowling community. Upon the retirement of Rick Schultz in 2013, Wayne County hired Lynda to continue to serve in that capacity. Also, since 2018, she provides service to the Mid Indiana High School as its Coordinator.

In 2015, Lynda was elected to the Indiana State board as District 5 Director where she held that position for three years until being elected as 3rd Vice President, then advanced through the chairs to her current position of the newly elected President of the Indiana State USBC. She has served on most State committees and has chaired many of them. Lynda continues as the Tournament Manager for Indiana State USBC Women's Championship and the Indiana State Mixed Championship.

Her accomplishments in the bowling world include the honor of being inducted into the Indiana State USBC Hall of Fame in 2023 and into the Wayne County USBC Hall of Fame in 2015 for her services to the bowling community. As coach for the Northeastern Girls High School for three years, they won their first-ever Sectional Team Event advancement into the High School Regionals, a Singles Event advancement into the Regionals, and a Regional Singles Event advancement into the Semi-State Finals.

Outside the bowling community, Lynda is the Office Manager for both Cutting Edge Physical Therapy clinics located in Richmond. Lynda and her husband, Paul, have two children and two grandchildren. Her spare time is taken with spending time with the grandchildren and sitting by the fire at home and enjoying the outdoors.
