The USBC policy requires at least four board positions (President, Vice President, Association Manager and a Director).

The first checkpoint of USBC's annual audit process is now a *re-check in March*. If not compliant, the centers will be relocated for service to a compliant association for the following season. Multiple communication touchpoints will be done along the way, but must be compliant in March to retain their local association charter.
