when they do not meet the eligibility requirements of being a Registered Volunteer.

The USBC policy requires at least four board positions (President, Vice President, Association Manager and a Director).

The first checkpoint of USBC's annual audit process is now a **re-check in March**. If not compliant, the centers will be relocated for service to a compliant association for the following season. Multiple communication touchpoints will be done along the way, but must be compliant in March to retain their local association charter.

All association board members should review their board's compliance with the monthly reports. If you haven't in the past few months, please visit [BOWL.com/Athlete Safety](https://www.bowl.com/AthleteSafety) to ensure you are up-to-date.
