DISTRICT CHALLENGE TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. This tournament is open to all associations within the Indiana State USBC.
- 2. Teams consist of 5 people. All team members must be a current board member or a life member of a State or Local Association, a local or State Hall of Fame member or state or local association staff member/employee. Teams may be all male, female or mixed. Members must be in good standing with a current USBC membership.
- 3. In the Qualifying Round, all teams will bowl two (2) standard team games and three (3) Baker-System Format games for seeding purposes into the elimination round brackets. The top 16 teams will advance to the Double Elimination Bracket Round.
- 4. The Double Elimination Bracket Round will then be bowled using the Baker-System format scoring. After the Qualifying Round, the top 16 teams will be seeded into the Winners Bracket based on their qualifying totals. (Rule 3).

Any tie for a seeding position will be determined by the highest regular team game from the Qualifying Round. If still tied, the highest Baker-System Format game will determine the winner.

If there is a tie for the last spot in the qualifying round, it will be determined by a 1-game Baker-System format roll-off. If still tied, a 9th & 10th frame roll-off using two (2) players of the captain's choice from each team will determine the advancing team.

- 5. Each match in the Double Elimination round will be one (1) Baker-System format game. All teams start in the WINNERS bracket; the team that wins the match will stay in the WINNERS bracket and the losing team will then move into the ELIMINATION bracket.
 - (a) If a team wins in the ELIMINATION bracket, they advance to the next round in that bracket.

- (b) When a team loses for the second time in the ELIMINATION bracket, they are now eliminated from the tournament and will receive the prize payout for that round and placing.
- (c) Ties are broken by a 9th & 10th frame roll-off of two (2) players of the captain's choice until a winner is determined.
- 6. Scratch scoring only. NO HANDICAP!
- 7. Entry fee will be \$50.00 per person. Prize fees will be returned 100%. Prize ratio is determined by the number of team entries of at least one (1) for every six (6) entries.
- 8. The winning district will host the following year's event & selection of a bowling center.
- Luncheon will be served immediately after qualification rounds are completed.
- 10. Individual brackets, individual high game pots, share the pot drawing and ball raffle may be held to offset expenses and prizes.
- 11. All entries must be received by September 1, 2025, in order to determine the meal and lane count for the event. Make all checks payable to Indiana USBC 8th District. September 1st is the deadline for entries.
- 12. This tournament is certified by the USBC.
- 13. Any disputes and concerns will be handled by the tournament manager and all decisions of the Tournament Manager are final.
