# 2026 Deloris Webb Memorial Adult/Youth Doubles Bowling Tournament

#### **RULES AND FORMAT**

- This tournament is sanctioned by the USBC and the INDIANA STATE USBC and shall be governed by the rules of USBC; USBC rule 400 will apply to both Youth and Adult.
- This will be a unisex tournament, male & female, male & male, or female & female.
- This tournament is open to any 2025-2026 USBC Certified Adult Bowler and 2025-2026 USBC Certified Youth Bowler.
- 4. All Bowlers Must use their highest certified league average with a minimum of 12 games on July 31, 2025 that can be verified on bowl.com. Anyone without a 2024-25 certified season average may use the highest 2025-2026 certified average for 12 games or more. If your current average is 10 pins higher, you will use it. Averages must be verified by a standing sheet at the time of bowling. Bowlers using an incorrect average will result in their score being disqualified and any winnings being forfeited. If there is not a 2025-2026 average, the bowler will bowl scratch (230). Certified string pin averages will be accepted for this tournament.
  - a. Rule 310d and 319e will be waived.
- 5. The handicap will be based on 100% of 230 averages.
- 6. There will be two (2) divisions: Team Average <u>325 and Under</u> and Team Average <u>326 and Above</u>.
- 7. All bowlers will bowl 3 games.
- 8. This tournament will consist of 2 member teams (1 Adult and 1 Youth Bowler).
  - a. Bowlers may bowl additional times in this tournament provided they bowl with different partners.
  - Adults may bowl with multiple youth bowlers at the same time, entry fee remains the same. It will go towards scholarships.
- All bowlers must wear suitable YOUTH TOURNAMENT attire. No clothing with offensive writing, alcohol or tobacco products.
  - a. The use of tobacco, vaping, or alcohol in any form during competition is prohibited by anyone.
- 10. Bowlers will be allowed 10 minutes of practice on starting lanes before their squad starts.
- 11. A bowler arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame which is being bowled. Frames missed shall be credited with a zero. A bowler not present and ready to bowl when it is his/her turn will be credited with a zero for that frame.
- 12. Only bowlers and Tournament Officials shall be permitted in the seating area during competition.
- Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the Tournament Manager no later than 30

- minutes after completion of the tournament. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the Tournament Manager within 48 hours or before the awards are given out. Each protest under this rule must be specific in itself.
- 14. Scholarships will be given to Youth Bowlers only for 1st and 2<sup>nd</sup> place in both Divisions. Additional scholarships may be awarded based on the number of entries received. For the Adult on the Champions and Runner-ups teams, a bowling ball will be awarded to them.
- 15. Awards will be returned 100% to bowlers based on 1 for 10 entries. Ties will be given the same award including scholarships if issued.
- 16. ENTRY FEE must be sent with the entry form. WALK-IN'S ARE CONSIDERED AS ANY ENTRY RECEIVED AFTER 5 PM ON FRIDAY SQUADS and 2 PM ON SATURDAY SQUADS. A \$20.00 LATE ENTRY FEE WILL BE ADDED TO THE ENTRY FEE FOR ANY WALK-IN'S.
- Advanced entries will be accepted up to April 18, 2026. Walkin entries will be accepted on a first come first basis each week no later than 1 hour prior to posted start time. Final entries close April 18, 2026.
- In consideration of ISUSBC conducting and Adult/Youth Tournament release ISUSBC and USBC from any and all liability for any injury or accident involving entrant as a result of entrant participating therein.
- 17. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations shall be determined by the Indiana State USBC TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE and the USBC.
- 18. Scholarships will be administered by the ISUSBC with funds being sent to the SMART Program under account #9991 at the United States Bowling Congress Office in Arlington, TX.
- 19.In case of center equipment failure or delay, the tournament manager will make the decision according to USBC rule 327c. If by war, fire, tornado, gas shortage, water damage, labor strikes, epidemic, etc. an Act of God, it becomes impossible to conduct or complete this tournament, as publicized, there shall be no further liability of the Deloris Webb Memorial Adult Youth Doubles Bowling Tournament to entrants.

SPECIAL NOTICE: ANYONE DISPLAYING UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT (CURSING, DELIBERATE FOULING, OBSCENE OR DEROGATORY GESTURES, KICKING BALL RETURNS OR WALLS, ETC.) MAY RESULTS IN DISQUALIFICATION. ANY BOWLER(S) CAUSING A DISTURBANCE as determined by either a complaint from other BOWLERS or as deemed disruptive by a Tournament Manager may lead to disqualification. This rule also includes parents or spectators and those issues will be addressed by having the person(s) removed from the center.
