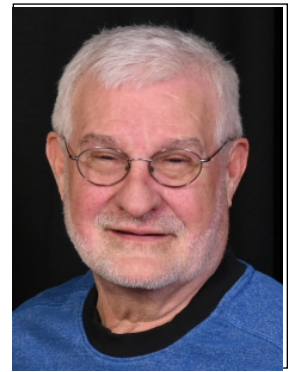

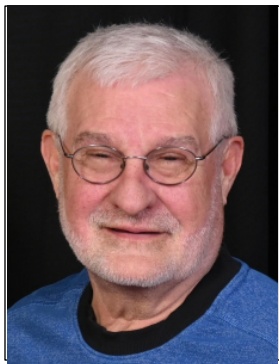

## Hall of Fame Nomination: Kenneth “Ken” Howard

Kenneth “Ken” Howard has devoted his life to the sport of bowling, not only as a competitive bowler but as a respected leader, mentor, and ambassador for the game. His decades-long commitment to both the business and community sides of bowling make him an outstanding candidate for Hall of Fame induction.

Ken’s journey in bowling began at just four years old at Greenwood Bowl. Born in 1951, he moved to Rushville, Indiana, in 1960 and returned there after college. While his early years on the lanes laid the foundation, it wasn’t until his late 20s that Ken’s true passion for the sport and its community — ignited.

Ken’s professional impact on bowling spans over four decades. He began working with Royal Pin in Indianapolis, one of the largest and most respected bowling center groups in the Midwest. He started at Jubilee Bowl in 1998/1999. His management career went on to Woodland Bowl for about 20 years, a couple of years at Expo and then retiring from Greenwood/Southern Bowl,

After his initial retirement, Ken was called back to the lanes and joined the New Castle Rose Bowl, where he worked another six years before retiring a second time. Even after that, his passion couldn't keep him away; today, he continues to give back to the sport, working part-time at Rushville Bowl, where it all began. A role of managing these centers for a combined impressive 30 years.

Ken’s influence extends far beyond the bowling lanes. He has been a dedicated leader in bowling associations at both the local and state levels:

- Indiana Bowling Centers Association (IBCA):
  - Board Member since the late 1990s
  - Secretary (2005–2007)
  - Vice President (2008–2009)
  - President (2010–2011)

From 1999 to 2011, Ken was responsible for managing the IBCA Annual Meeting Trade Show which is a major event involving dozens of vendors and many, many attendees. He handled logistics, vendor coordination, and overall execution, working closely with Executive Directors Heather Brownell. His leadership and professionalism earned him deep respect across the state bowling community.

Ken currently serves as First Vice President on the Rush County Bowling Association Board of Directors, continuing his lifelong commitment to supporting local bowlers.

Ken is not only a leader in bowling management — he's also had an outstanding career on the lanes:

- Rushville Bowl House Record: Rolled an 842 series in 1996, which stood as the house record for 18 years (until 2014).
- 800 series: October 2004 and again in January 2020 at age 65
- Perfect Game (300): February 2008
- 299 Games: April 2008 and April 2012
- 296 Game: January 2006
- USBC National Tournament: Completed his 40th year in 2025
- Averaged 200+ still at the age of 70 over the last 5 years.
- 5+ local city tourney titles.

Ken was also inducted into the Rush County Hall of Fame in 2014, a testament to his outstanding local contributions.

Ken Howard has given his heart and soul to bowling. His career reflects not just a love for the game but a selfless commitment to growing the sport and supporting everyone in the bowling community, from league bowlers to business owners, from tournament organizers to first-time youth participants.

He's a mentor, leader, and lifelong ambassador of bowling. His decades of service and success both behind the scenes and on the lanes make him more than worthy of Hall of Fame induction.

There is no one more deserving than Ken Howard.
