INSTRUCTIONS AND APPLICATION

\$1000 Indiana State USBC Star of Tomorrow Scholarship (Male or Female)

\$1000 Indiana State USBC Male or Female Performance Scholarship

\$1000 Indiana State USBC Male or Female Scholarship (focus on meritorious service)

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Any high school junior or senior is eligible to receive the scholarship providing the student meets requirements.

Applications will not be considered without ALL REQUIRED INFORMATION.

1. Must be a bowler and a member of the Indiana State USBC for at least 3 years
2. Must be a high school senior or high school junior. (A Junior winner is not able to apply again their Senior year.)
******non-traditional students will be considered with submission of appropriate documentation regarding their participation in Indiana bowling and schooling.******
3. All scholarship money will be dispersed through the USBC SMART Program. Students must provide SMART information as requested by the association manager to receive any awarded scholarships. All scholarships awarded will follow the SMART program rules and guidelines.
4. Must file an application furnished by the IS USBC Scholarship Committee, giving complete information as required thereon, postmarked by **MAY 15**
5. Must have Amateur status in all Athletics

APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

- **Step 1**—Completely submit the current Indiana State USBC Scholarship Application including information on your bowling and school accomplishments. Feel free to attach any additional information you would like to share with the Scholarship Committee for review.
- **Step 2**—Submit an essay of not less than 100 words and not more than 150 words, telling what your specific college plans are. Judging will be based on plans, clarity, organization, and logic.
- **Step 3**— Request a letter of recommendation from your bowling coach or mentor. Form included can be used or additional document may be submitted.
- **Step 4**— Request a copy of your current transcripts to be included with your application.
