Associations and bowling centers interested in hosting a state tournament during the 2027–2028 season are encouraged to review and submit an RFP.

All hosting requirements for each tournament are included in a single document. The RFP form is designed to be completed electronically using **Adobe Acrobat or Adobe Reader**. To complete the form, first save the document to your computer with a unique file name. You can then fill out and save the completed form electronically or print the document and

complete it manually.

Hosts selected for the 2027–2028 tournaments will be announced during the **Indiana State USBC Annual Meeting on June 21, 2026**.

Associations and centers are encouraged to review the requirements and consider submitting a proposal to showcase their community and bowling facilities.

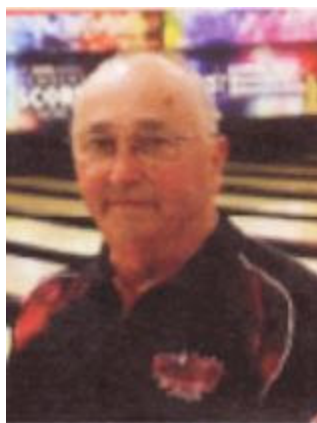
