Spare A Life Tournament Rules and Format

1. This tournament is certified by USBC and shall be governed by the rules of the USBC. Rule 400 will apply. This tournament is open to all 2025 – 2026 certified youth and adult bowlers.
2. This tournament will use the bowler's highest 2025-2026 certified season ending average for 15 games or more, fall, winter or summer. Average verification will be required for all cashing and scholarship positions. Averages will be attempted to be verified via bowl.com or provided standing sheet. A bowler that does not have an average for the 2025 -2026 Season or has an average with less than 15 games will bowl scratch using a 230 average. A Bowler using an incorrect average will be subject to their score being disqualified and any winnings being forfeited. Certified sport league averages will be adjusted per USBC average conversion chart. Rules 319d and 319e will be waived.
3. Entry fees are broken down as follows (Youth Entry \$55.00) Youth Scholarship fund \$30.00. Lineage \$13.50. Expenses \$11.50. (Adult entry \$55) Suicide Prevention \$15. Lineage \$13.50. Expenses \$11.50. Prize fund \$15.00. Prize fund money will be returned 100%. All walk-in fees will be added to the Scholarship Prize Fund. A donation to the Local Suicide Prevention Chapter will be made from the proceeds of all raffles and split pots.
4. Entry Fees: No entry will be accepted without payment. Payments may be made in cash or check/money order made payable to "ISUSBC". Walk in entries are Cash Only on the day of competition. Walk-in entries are accepted provided space is available.
5. Handicap: Handicap is based on 90% of 230.
6. Format/Scoring: Bowlers will receive 10 minutes of practice and bowl 3 games on the same pair of lanes. The total pin series of the 3 games plus handicap will determine the winner. If a tie occurs, then the bowlers will split the prize money/scholarship winnings equally. Any bowler arriving late shall begin play and their score will begin with the frame being bowled. All frames missed will receive a zero.
7. Dress Code: All bowlers must wear suitable attire. Shorts must be below fingertips when arms are hanging at the side. No bare mid-drifts or cut-offs permitted or clothing with offensive writing, alcohol, and tobacco products. Suicide prevention colors, teal and purple are highly recommended.
8. Only Bowlers and Tournament Officials shall be permitted in the settee area during competition.
9. After a score is recorded it cannot be changed unless there is an obvious error in scoring or calculation. Questionable errors shall be decided on by the Tournament Management. Claims for errors must be made to the Tournament Manager no later than 24 hours after the completion of the tournament and UNOFFICIAL results are posted.
10. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed on the concourse of the tournament. Bowlers are not permitted to take smoke breaks during the tournament.
11. Awards: Scholarship and Prize Money will be returned 100% to bowlers based on a one (1) and six (6) ratio.
12. As a participant of this tournament, you are giving your consent for the ISUSBC to use any pictures of participants taken during participation or as a result of participation.
13. In consideration of ISUSBC conducting the Tournament Participants releases ISUSBC and USBC from any and all liability for any injury or accident involving entrant as a result of entrant participating therein.
14. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations shall be determined by the USBC Rule Book and the Tournament Manager. Any further protest will be determined by the USBC Rules Department.
