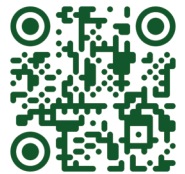

2026 INDIANA SENIOR MASTERS RULES

- ELIGIBILITY:** Each participant must be a current Indiana USBC member in good standing, and live in Indiana, or have at least 21 games in an Indiana association league, during the **2025-2026** season, or the current **2026-2027** season. This is a Scratch Tournament. Bowler must have been born before **10/23/1976**
- A DRESS CODE** will be enforced during the **TOURNAMENT**. Each Participant must wear DRESS SLACKS, No denim, Cargo Pants or shorts, workout gear, sweatpants, or patch pockets. **SHIRT** with a **COLLAR** (No T-Shirts or tank tops allowed). Jerseys with bowling logos that meet PBA guidelines will be allowed. A Shirt with your name on it is NOT REQUIRED. **Those individuals not complying with the DRESS CODE will not be permitted to bowl**
- ALL participants** are asked to be at the Host Center and **CHECK-IN 30 Minutes prior to Squad Time**. Management reserves the right to fill any vacancy 20 minutes prior to the start of a squad with walk-ins. **Announcements and practice are scheduled to begin 15 minutes prior to scheduled squad time.** **Bowlers arriving late will be given ZERO for any frames missed.**
- In the event of a breakdown or delay, the Tournament Manager will make a decision regarding the continuation of the game/games. If scores are irretrievably lost in an automatic scorer that game must be bowled over. No individuals are permitted in the bowling area except participants and tournament officials.
- All decisions of the Tournament Manager are Final, pending appeal to USBC. Management reserves the right to refuse an entry.
- ENTRY FEE : \$100.** (Discounted to \$80. If Paid by October 9th, 2026) \$50. Prize Fee - Balance Lineage and Expenses.
- RE-ENTRY FEE : \$80.** \$50. Prize Fee - Balance Lineage and Expenses.
- ALL PRIZE FEES RETURNED 100% in PRIZES in at least a 1 in 5 Ratio. Bowlers may only Cash Once.**
- REFUNDS** - Any request for a Refund or Transfer of a paid entry if allowed may incur a \$10. Fee.
- Lane Pattern will not be a House Shot, and will be Kegel Beaten Path.
- Ball surface adjustments may only be made until practice is over, No surface adjustments between games in Finals.
- USBC rules will govern this competition. Tournament Director has final ruling in any dispute not covered.
- There will be 3 classes, all competing in 1 Qualifying Group for 1 Prize List.**
These classes will be (SD) - (Super Duper Senior) Those that have reached 70 years old by **Oct. 23, 2026**
(SS) - (Super Senior) Those that have reached 60 years old by **Oct. 23, 2026**
(S) - (Senior) Those that have reached 50 years old by **Oct. 23, 2026**
- FORMAT: QUALIFYING** - Squad will consist of 4 Games. A bowler may re-enter if they would like, but can only keep their highest score for cashing purposes. At least 1 in 5 Overall will Cash. If there is a tie for the Last Place to Advance there will be a 1 Game Roll-off.

FINALS - The field will be cut to the TOP 16 based on the following guidelines
Top 4 from SD or SS Class, with at least 1 SD | Next 12 - Scores from any Class
Bowlers will then be seeded based on qualifying score, ties broken by high games.
A Finalist that misses Roll Call for Finals will be replaced by an alternate if available.

All bowlers start in the WINNERS bracket, if you win your match you stay in the Winners bracket. If you lose a match, you move to the Elimination bracket. If you win your match in the Elimination bracket, you advance to the next round. When you lose for the second time, you are eliminated from the tournament and receive the prize payout for that round and place.
